



Food Business Support Grant Application Form

The RBG Food Business grants are funded by RBG through the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, a UK government programme, and is designed to direct funding to food businesses that are based or trade in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a local business, charity or social enterprise food business or project.
- Have achieved the GFIG Hospitality, Community or Retail Charter
- Be based in the Royal Borough of Greenwich and/or provide services to the community within RBG.
- Have a bank account in the organisation's name.
- Apply for a minimum of £500 and a maximum of £2,000 per application (only one application per organisation is allowed).
- Apply within the designated application period (start date 27th November 2024, end date 28th February 2025) on the designated application form.
- All successful applicants must agree to provide information on their spend and the impact of the investment from the Grant from RBG.

Terms and conditions

Please note, the funder's/organisers' decision is final and there is no appeals process.

Businesses signed up to the scheme will be able to apply for grant funding as part of the RBG Generative Business programme.

Organisations need to complete the form and provide full information as detailed in the application; failure to do so may result in your application being nullified.

Grants are for a minimum of £500 and a maximum of £2,000 - grant applications outside these parameters will be subject to disqualification if they breach the terms and conditions of this project.

The organisers' reserve the right to close the scheme earlier if the level of applications and demand for the scheme is significant.

RBG and GCDa do not accept responsibility for any loss which may arise from reliance on information from, or support provided by, this programme. We also reserve the right to withhold or terminate a grant offer if we consider the terms and conditions to have been breached.
